The bad weather in June and July made the RPL a very popular place to hang out! The Summer Reading Program was a great success. Over 50 children between the ages of 6 and 12 filled in weekly reading logs and came to library for prizes and activities. Lots of kids who did not sign up still came to participate in the free weekly programs. The Town Wide Treasure hunt was extremely popular and will become an annual summer tradition at the library. Hundreds of books were donated over the summer and volunteers worked to catalogue an additional 1,300 new titles into the collection. We have approximately 11,000 books in the library and our goal is to complete the cataloguing process by the end of the year.
